THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me VERA CECILIA DALE of Onehunga Spinster

1. I HEREBY REVOKE all former wills and testamentary dispositions at any time heretofore made by me and declare this to be my last will.
2. I APPOINT my brother JOHN SPENCER CAMPBELL DALE and my niece BARBARA GWENDOLINE TOCKER to be the executors and trustees of this my will.
3. I GIVE AND BEQUEATH the sum of TWO HUNDRED POUNDS (£200) to the Parish Priest for the time being at the Catholic Church at Onehunga for masses for the repose of the souls of my parents my brothers and myself.
4. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH unto my brother JOHN SPENCER CAMPBELL DALE my interest in the freehold property at 30 Arthur Street, Onehunga together with all of the furniture therein owned by me and my piano and crystal china and my solitaire diamond ring and amethyst ring.
5. I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the rest residue and remainder of my estate both real and personal of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situate of which I shall be possessed to which I shall be entitled or over which I shall have any disposing power at my death in equal shares to the said JOHN SPENCER CAMPBELL DALE and BARBARA GWENDOLINE TOCKER

IN WITNESS WHEREOF I have to this my will set my hand this 27th day of February One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven (1967).




